With this revised Class Registration Policy, the Hardin County Family YMCA will utilize the new policy as part of the feedback from class participants as to the quality of the class/program offering.

Hardin County Family YMCA Class Registration Policy

New policy takes affect 10/1/2016

- Includes all fitness and aquatic (swim lessons, aquacize, etc.) classes

Minimum class size sign-up

- All classes (member-benefit and pay classes) minimum registration to conduct class for the month is 4.

Class Registration Policy Deadline

- Sign-up by the LAST THURSDAY of every month for the following month classes (or any future month's class)

With this policy, the Hardin County Family YMCA commits to the following:

1. Once the class minimum of 4 is met, the class will meet as scheduled for the month– even if less than 4 show up on any given day/night.
 - a. Instructor could choose an alternate activity for evening depending on the nature of the class.
 - b. OK so there's always an exception – If no one shows up for a class, class will not be conducted.
☺
2. As part of feedback on a class offering, if the class has less than 4 registrants for 3 consecutive months, class may be discontinued.
 - a. Summer months by their nature are less active class times; therefore based on non-summer month attendance, YMCA may choose to suspend class until fall.
